To allow for compensational weight gain, all animals will be given time to settle in a holding paddock. All stock will be fed hay for a period of five days prior to the initial competition weigh in.

## Special Conditions and Entry Requirements

1. The Royal Agricultural Society of NSW (RAS) run this competition in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in the RAS General Regulations, the Special Cattle Regulations, and the 2012 Cattle Schedule.
2. Pens will consist of 6 animals, with all 6 animals being included in all points scores, including the final carcass points score.
3. Feeding of cattle for the **60 day Domestic Class** and **100 day Export Class** will be at Wilga Feedlot (WF) Bellata.
  - Steers/heifers for the **100 day Export Class** must arrive with a completed NVD (National Vendor Declaration) by **3pm Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2011**.
  - Steers/heifers for the **60 day Domestic Class** must arrive with a completed NVD (National Vendor Declaration) by **3pm Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2011**.
  - Steers/heifers will be inducted and allowed to settle in a holding paddock on hay only for a period of 5 days prior to the initial weigh in for the competition to allow for compensational gain.
4. Heifers entered in the **100 day Export Class** will incur a 5 cent deduction on the carcass grid.
5. Entry values for all classes will be calculated from the EYCI on the day of entry onto feed.
6. Competition shall be a minimum of 10 entries in each Class.
7. No Hormonal Growth Promotants (HGP's) allowed for the **60 Day Domestic Class**.
8. HGP's will be allowed for the **100 day Export Class only**. Exhibitors to contact WF for advice.
9. A live assessment and judging day/field day for both competitions will be held approximately 7 days prior to slaughter on **Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2012** at Wilga Feedlot Bellata. (Timing will minimise stress impact on animals prior to slaughter).
10. RAS will cover payment of feedlot costs until slaughter. At such time –
  - a. All costs associated from the Competition relating to Exhibitor entries will be deducted from final Sale proceeds;
  - b. this includes all feed costs;
  - c. health and induction costs;
  - d. transport to abattoir;
  - e. slaughter and levy costs;
  - f. freight costs for selected cuts to the showgrounds; and
  - g. any associated expenses.
11. For the **60 day Domestic Class** an entry will consist of a pen of 6 steers and/or heifers showing no more than two teeth, and will not be exited if they break four teeth.
12. For the **100 day Export Class** an entry will consist of a pen of 6 steers showing no more than 2 teeth, and a 5 point deduction if they break four teeth.
13. For the **60 day Domestic Class** animals will be processed at Australian Country Choice, Cannon Hill, Brisbane.
14. For the **100 day Export Class** animals will be processed at Kilcoy Pastoral Company, Kilcoy.
15. From each team entered, an individual carcass will be selected based on carcass points score for the **Taste Test Competition**.
16. The RAS and WF and associated employees and volunteers will use all reasonable care and skill to ensure the animals health and safety, however the RAS and WF accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to any animal, person or property as a result of entering into this competition and all entrants acknowledge that entry is at their own risk, cost and exposure.
17. The RAS has the right to decline any entrant entry into this competition and reject any entry for any reason whatsoever and the RAS' decisions in this respect shall be final. No discussions or correspondence will be entered into with the RAS regarding reasons for any declines or rejections.
